

Vintage Fancy

Supplies Needed:

(all yardages based on 42" usable fabric)

~1 Layer Cake or (40) 10" squares (for center, both petal borders, flying geese border, rectangles border)

~1/4 yd. solid or small print for 1st non-pieced border

~1/3 yd. solid or small print for 2nd non-pieced border

~1/4 yd. solid or small print for 3rd non-pieced border

~1/3 yd. solid or small print for 4th non-pieced border

~1/8 yd. *each* of 3 fabrics for corner squares

~3 1/4 yards background fabric

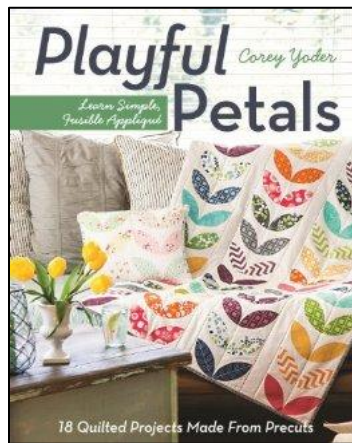
~1/2 yard binding fabric

~4 1/8 yards backing fabric

~2 yards paper backed fusible web*

~74" x 74" batting

*I use HeatnBond Lite

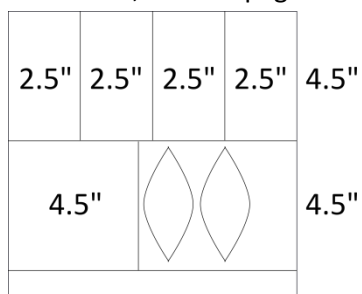

Cutting Instructions

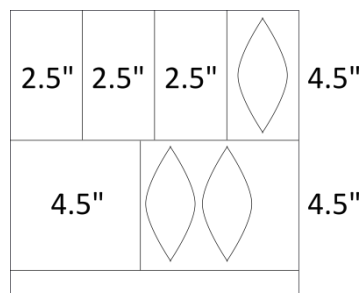
wof=width of fabric

From the Layer Cake Squares cut as indicated:

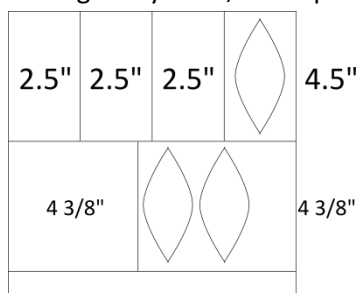
From each of **(8)** squares cut: (4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles, (1) 4.5" square, and 2 petals (Note: Petal Template can be found on page 69 in the Playful Petals book, refer to page 10 for petal construction information):



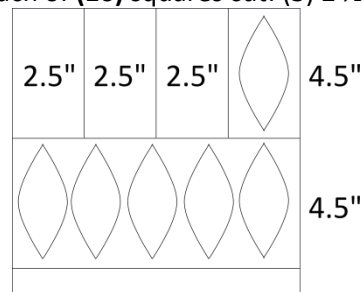
From each of **(4)** squares cut: (3) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles, (1) 4 ½" square and 3 petals:



From each of **(12)** squares cut (3) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles, (1) 4 3/8" square cut diagonally once, and 3 petals:



From each of **(16)** squares cut: (3) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles and (6) petals:



From the 1st non-pieced border fabric cut(border A):

(2) 2" x 21 ½" strips & (2) 2" x 24 ½" strips

From the 2nd non-pieced border fabric cut(border B):

(2) 2 ½" x 36 ½" strips & (2) 2 ½" x 40 ½" strips

From the 3rd non-pieced border fabric cut(border C):

(5) 1 ½" x wof strips, trim selvages, sew end to end, and cut (2) 1 ½" x 48 ½" strips and (2) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips

From the 4th non-pieced border fabric cut(border D):

(6) 1 ½" x wof strips, trim selvages, sew end to end, and cut (2) 1 ½" x 58 ½" strips and (2) 1 10/2" x 60 ½" strips

From 1 of the 1/8 yd cuts of fabric cut **(4)** 3 ½" squares

From each of the remaining 1/8 yd cuts of fabric cut **(4)** 4 ½" squares

From the background fabric cut:

- (2) 11 3/8" squares, cut diagonally once
- (2) 4 ½" x wof strip; subcut into (12) 4 ½" squares
- (3) 6 ½" x wof strips; subcut into (20) 6 ½" squares
- (10) 2 ½" x wof strips; subcut into (160) 2 ½" squares
- (6) 2 ½" x wof strips; subcut into (52) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles
- (7) 3 ½" x wof strips; subcut into (40) 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles

From the binding fabric cut:

(7) 2 1/8" x wof strips, trim selvages, sew end to end to make continuous binding

From the backing fabric:

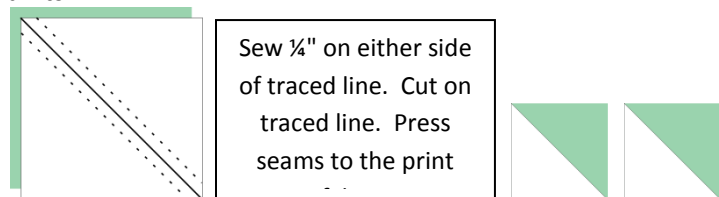
(2) 74" x wof strips, sew together to create the backing

Piecing Instructions

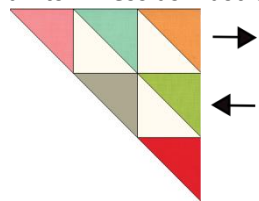
Use a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance

Center Block

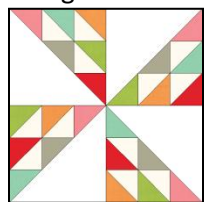
1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the (12) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares.
2. Pair each $4\frac{1}{2}$ " background square with a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " print square right sides together. Use the stitch and flip method to create 12 half square triangles (hst's). Trim to 4" square. Note: You will use 1/2 of these units.



3. Sew together the hst's and the print triangles as illustrated. Make 4 units. Press as illustrated. Press as illustrated.



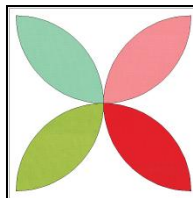
4. Sew the units made in Step 3 and the white background triangles. Make 4 blocks. Sew together to complete the center. Press to background fabric.



5. Sew the 2" x $21\frac{1}{2}$ " border A strips to the sides of the center block. Press away from the center. Sew the 2" x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " border A strips to the top and bottom. Press away from center.

Orange Peel Border

1. Fuse & stitch 4 petals onto each 6" background square as illustrated. Applique instructions can be found on pages 10-16 in Playful Petals. Make 20 blocks.



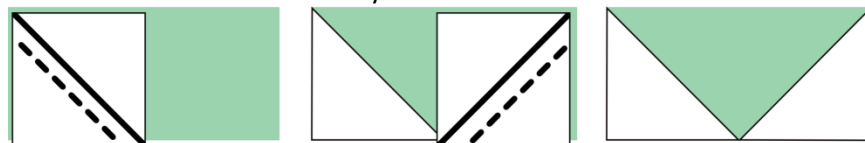

2. Sew together 2 sets of 4 blocks. Press seams in one direction. Sew to the sides of the center. Press to the center. Sew together 2 sets of 6 blocks. Press seams in one direction. Sew to the top and bottom of the center. Press to the center.

3. Sew the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " border B strips to the sides of the center. Press away from the center. Sew the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " border B strips to the top and bottom. Press away from the center.

Flying Geese Border

1. Draw a diagonal line across the back of each $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background square. Use 80 print $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and the marked squares to create 80 flying geese units. Use the stitch and flip method to make these as illustrated. Press away from Print Fabric



2. Sew together 4 strips of 20 flying geese. Press in one direction. Sew 2 strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the center. Sew a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square to each end of the remaining flying geese strips. Press toward the squares. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the center.

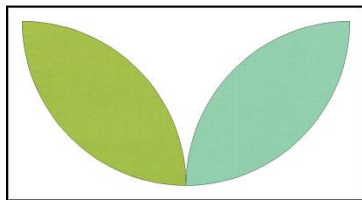
3. Sew the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " border C strips to the sides of the center. Press away from the center. Sew the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{2}$ " border C strips to the top and bottom. Press seams away from center.

Coin Border

1. Sew together 12 print $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and 13 background $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Begin and end with a background rectangle. Alternate print/background fabrics. Press toward the print. Make a total of 4 strips.
2. Sew 2 strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the center. Sew a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square to each end of the remaining coin strips. Press toward the squares. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the center.
3. Sew the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $58\frac{1}{2}$ " border D strips to the sides of the center. Press away from the center. Sew the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " border D strips to the top and bottom. Press seams away from center.

Half Peel Border

1. Fuse & stitch 2 petals onto each $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle as illustrated. Applique instructions can be found on pages 10-16 in Playful Petals. Make 40 blocks.



Make 40

2. Sew together 4 sets of 10 blocks as illustrated. Press seams in one direction.



3. Sew 2 strips to the sides of the quilt. Press seams toward the center. Sew a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square to the ends of the remaining strips. Press toward the squares. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the center.

Complete the Quilt

Prepare a quilt sandwich using the quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired and bind using the prepared binding.
