


Layer Cake Log Cabin Quilt Block Tutorial

Supplies:

To Make a Quilt top 60" x 75" you will need (2) layer cakes or a total of (80) 10" squares.

The finished Log Cabin quilt blocks will measure 7 1/2" square.



Separate the (80) 10" squares into (40) light squares and (40) dark squares. Use the cutting diagrams below to cut each of the 10" squares.

40 **Light** 10" Squares

2"x3 1/2"	2"x6 1/2"	
2"x3 1/2"	2"x6 1/2"	
2"x2"	2"x5"	
2"x2"	2"x5"	

40 **Dark** 10" Squares

2"x2"	2"x8"	
2"x2"	2"x8"	
2"x3 1/2"	2"x6 1/2"	
2"x3 1/2"	2"x6 1/2"	
2"x5"	2"x5"	

Construct (80) 8" Log Cabin blocks (blocks will measure 7 1/2" finished) using traditional log cabin piecing methods. Use a 1/4" seam allowance and press away from the center. Lay out the quilt top in 10 rows of 8 blocks each. Rotate blocks as desired.
