

## Fabrics Needed:

The pieces listed under "Constructing the Blocks" on page 17 of Sunday Best Quilts

In addition, you will need the following:
(12) $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border squares (A)
(4) $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background rectangles (B)
(4) $1^{1 / 1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background rectangles (C)
(4) $1^{1 / 1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background rectangles (D)

## Block Construction

1. Following the instructions listed under "Constructing the Blocks" on pages 17 \& 18 of Sunday Best Quilts, construct 1 On a Whim quilt block.
2. Sew a (B) background rectangle to both sides of the completed block. Press away from the center.
3. Sew an (A) border square to the sides of the two remaining (B) background rectangles. Press toward (B). Sew these two units to the top/bottom of the block. See Diagram 1.
4. Sew a (C) background rectangle to the sides of the block. Press away from the center.
5. Sew an (A) border square to the sides of the two remaining (C) background rectangles. Press toward (C). Sew these two units to the top/bottom of the block. See Diagram 2.
6. Sew a (D) background rectangle to the sids of the block. Press away from the center.
7. Sew an (A) border square to the sides of the two remaining (D) background rectangles. Press toward (D). Sew these two units to the top/bottom of the block. See Diagram 3. This completes your On a Whim Sampler block. The block should measure $18 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.
