

Driftwood Drive Sampler Block

Fabrics Needed:

The pieces listed under "Constructing the Blocks" on pages 35-36 of Sunday Best Quilts

In addition, you will need the following:

- (1) rectangle 2 ½" x 8 ½" (A)
- (2) rectangles 2 ½" x 10 ½" (B)
- (1) rectangle 2 ½" x 12 ½" (C)
- (12) 1 ½"border squares (D)
- (4) 1 ½" x 12 ½" background rectangles (E)
- (4) 1 ½" x 14 ½" background rectangles (F)
- (4) 1 ½" x 16 ½" background rectangles (G)

Block Construction




- 1. Following the instructions listed under "Constructing the Blocks" on pages 35-36 of Sunday Best Quilts, construct 1 Driftwood Drive quilt block.
- 2. Sew the (A) rectangle to the top of the completed block. Press away from the center.
- 3. Sew the (B) rectangle to the left side of the completed block. Press away from the center.
- 4. Sew the other (B) rectangle to the bottom of the completed block. Press away from the center.
- 5. Sew the (C) rectangle to the right side of the completed block. Press away from the center.
- 6. Sew an (E) rectangle to both sides of the block. Press away from the center.



- 7. Sew a (D) border square to the sides of the two remaining (E) background rectangles. Press towards (E). Sew these two units to the top/bottom of the block. Press away from the center.
- 8. Sew an (F) rectangle to both sides of the block. Press away from the center.
- 9. Sew a (D) border square to the sides of the two remaining (F) background rectangles. Press towards (F). Sew these two units to the top/bottom of the block. Press away from the center.
- 10. Sew a (G) background rectangle to both sides of the block. Press away from the center.
- 11. Sew the remaining (D) border squares to the sides of the two remaining (G) background rectangles. Press towards (G). Sew these two units to the top/bottom of the block. Press away from the center.

This completes your Driftwood Drive Sampler block. The block should measure 18 ½" x 18 ½".
