

## Starling Sampler Block

## Fabrics Needed:

The pieces listed under "Constructing the Blocks" on pages 23-24 of Sunday Best Quilts

In addition you will need the following:
(4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " border squares (A)
(2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 15 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ background rectangles (B)
(2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 16 \frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangles (C)
(4) 1 ½" $\times 16 \frac{1 ⁄ 2 "}{}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ background rectangles (D)

## Block Construction

1. Following the instructions listed under "Constructing the Blocks" on pages 23-24 of Sunday Best Quilts, construct 1 Starling quilt block.
2. Sew a (B) rectangle to both sides of the completed block. Press away from the center.
3. Sew a (C) rectangle to the top/bottom of the completed block. Press away from the center. See Diagram 1.
4. Sew a (D) rectangle to both sides of the block. Press away from the center.
5. Sew an (A) border square to the sides of the two remaining (D) background rectangles. Press towards (D). Sew these two units to the top/bottom of the block. Press away from the center. See Diagram 2.

This completes your Starling Sampler block. The block should measure $181 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
