

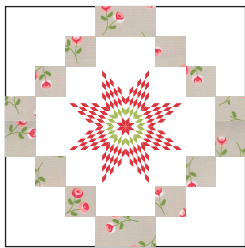

## Beautiful Day Mystery BOM

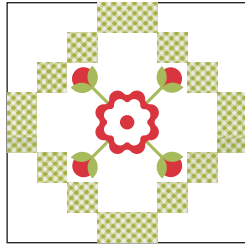
### Block 2: Rosy Wonder

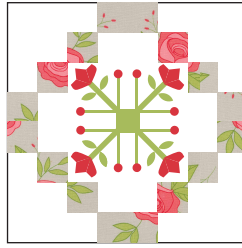




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# block assembly

RST=right sides together

use a ¼" seam allowance

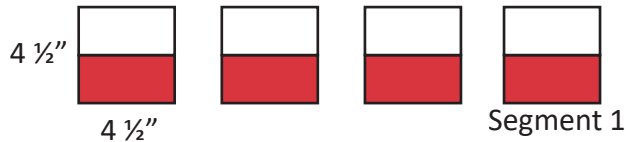
read through all instructions before beginning

Gather the pieces needed to complete Block A.

1. Sew together a background (C) strip and a print (E) strip as illustrated. The strip unit will measure 4 ½" x 18 ½".



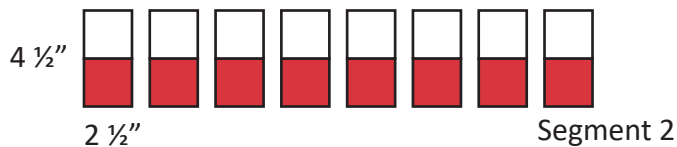
2. Subcut the strip unit into 4 segments measuring 4 ½" x 4 ½" each. (Segment 1)



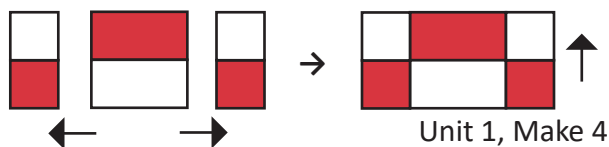
3. Sew together a background (B) strip and a print (D) strip as illustrated. The strip unit will measure 4 ½" x 20 ½".



4. Subcut the strip unit into 8 segments measuring 2 ½" x 4 ½" each. (Segment 2)



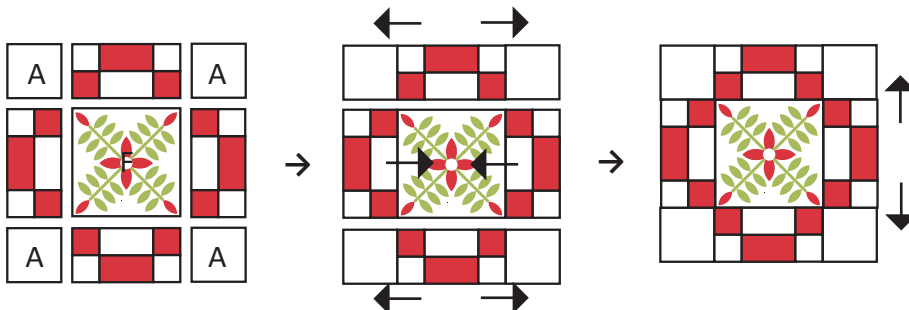
5. Sew together segments 1 & 2 as shown to make Unit 1. Unit 1 measures 4 ½" x 8 ½". Make 4.



6. Sew together the four Unit 1s, four background (A) squares, and 1 panel (F) square to complete 1 Rosy Wonder block.

Press as Illustrated

The block will measure 16 ½" x 16 ½".



7. Make a total of 4 Rosy Wonder blocks.

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
