







## Beautiful Day Mystery BOM Finishing Instructions

| <br>9900-200 | <b>Sashing &amp; First Border</b><br>31 rectangles, 2 ½" x 16 ½"    A<br>9 strips, 2 ½" x width of fabric    B |
| <br>29136-31 | <b>Cornerstones</b><br>12 squares, 2 ½" x 2 ½"    C  |
| <br>29132-22 | <b>Outer Border</b><br>10 strips, 6 ½ x width of fabric    D   |
| <br>29135-11 | <b>Binding</b><br>10 strips, 2 ½ x width of fabric    E  |
| Backing   | 3 ¼ yard 108" wide 108000-22   |
| Batting   | 94" X 112"   |



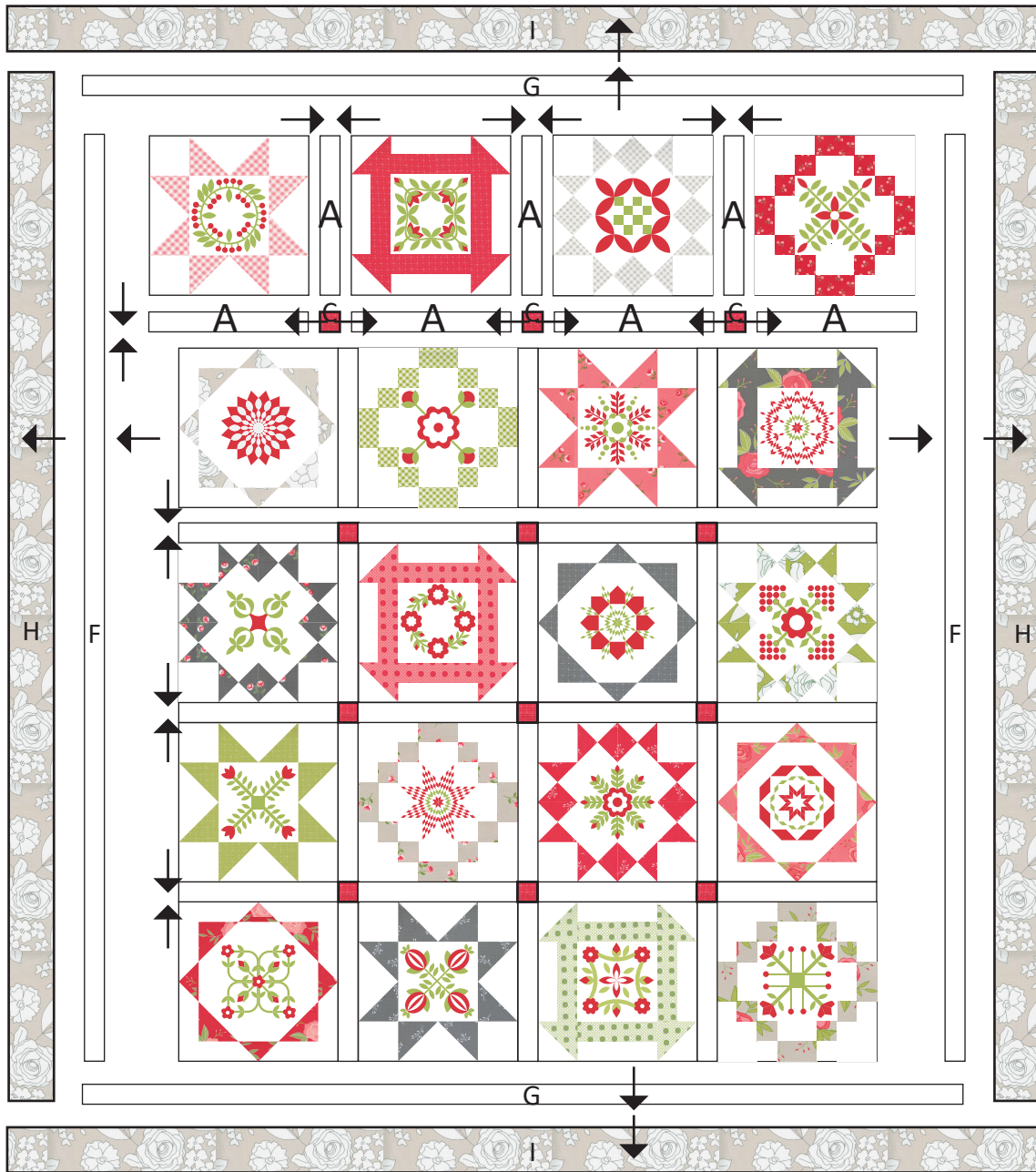

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## quilt center

use  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances and press as indicated by arrows.

Each row of blocks will need 4 pieced blocks and 3 background **(A)** rectangles. Press toward **(A)**

Each sashing strip row will need 4 background **(A)** rectangles and 3 **(C)** cornerstones. Press toward **(A)**

Sew together the quilt center. The quilt center will measure  $70 \frac{1}{2}$  x  $88 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

Follow the instructions on the following page to add the borders to the quilt center.

## borders

*use ¼" seam allowances*

*all borders are pressed away from the center.*

Trim selvages and sew the background **(B)** strips together end to end.

Subcut into the following borders:

2 inner, side borders, 2 ½ x 88 ½" **(F)**

2 inner, top/bottom borders, 2 ½" x 74 ½" **(G)**

Trim selvages and sew the outer border **(D)** strips end to end.

Subcut into the following borders:

2 outer side borders, 6 ½" x 92 ½" **(H)**

2 outer top/bottom borders, 6 ½" x 86 ½" **(I)**

Attach borders. They will be added in the order listed above (F,G,H,I). ***Press all borders away from the center.***

The completed quilt top will measure 86 ½" x 104 ½".

## finishing

Baste the quilt top, batting, and backing fabric together using your preferred method.

Quilt as desired.

Trim selvages and prepare the binding using the **(E)** strips. Bind the quilt.
