## patchwork border

use $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances

Sew together $6(A)$ squares to make unit 1. Press seams in one direction. Unit 1 will measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Repeat to make a total of 24 Unit 1.

Using 16 of the $(\mathbf{B})$ strips cut the following:
(48) rectangles, $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}(\mathrm{H})$

Sew $(\mathbf{H})$ to the top and bottom of each Unit 1 to create a patchwork border. Press away from (H). Each patchwork border will measure $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

Make 24 patchwork borders.
