
## assemble the quilt center

use 1/4" seam allowances

Sew together 4 star blocks and 3 patchwork borders to make a sashing row.

Press toward the patchwork borders.


Make a total of 4 sashing rows each measuring 4 ½" x 52 ½".



Sew together 3 Oh, Happy Day! blocks and 4 patchwork borders to create a block row.

Press toward the patchwork borders.

Make a total of 3 block rows each measuring 12 ½" x 52 ½".




The Oh, Happy Day! block of the week is brought to you by Corey Yoder of Coriander Quilts.



Sew together the sashing rows and block rows to create the quilt center. Press toward the sashing rows.

See the following page for instructions on adding the remaining borders.



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## borders

use ¼" seam allowances all borders are pressed away from the center.

Trim selvages and sew the remaining 6 background (B) strips together end to end.

Subcut into the following borders:

2 inner, side borders, 1 ½ x 52 ½" (M) 2 inner, top/bottom borders, 1 ½" x 54 ½" (N)

Trim selvages and sew the outer border (E) strips end to end.

Subcut into the following borders:

2 outer, side borders, 4 ½" x 54 ½" (O) 2 outer, top/bottom borders, 4 ½" x 62 ½" (P)

Attach borders. They will be added in the order listed above (M,N,O,P). Press all borders away from the center.

The completed quilt top will measure 62 ½" x 62 ½".

## finishing

Sew the two backing pieces together to create quilt backing measuring approximately 71" x 71".

Baste the quilt top, batting, and backing fabric together using your preferred method.

Quilt as desired.

Trim selvages and prepare the binding using the (F) strips. Bind the quilt.
