- (10) 3" green squares
- (16) 2 1/2" green squares
- (10) 3" background squares
- (12) 1 1/2" background squares

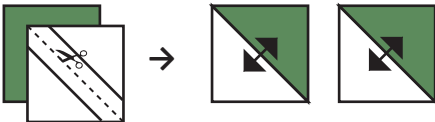
Piecing Instructions

Press all seams open

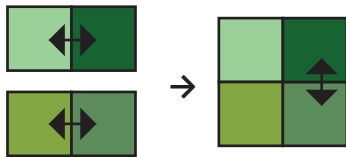
RST = Right Sides Together

1. Mark a diagonal line across the back of a 3" background square. Place the background square RST with a 3" green square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the marked line. Cut the unit apart on the drawn line. You will have two half square triangles.

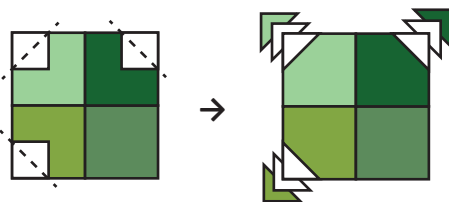
Trim each half square triangle to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2". Repeat to make 20 half square triangles (HSTs).



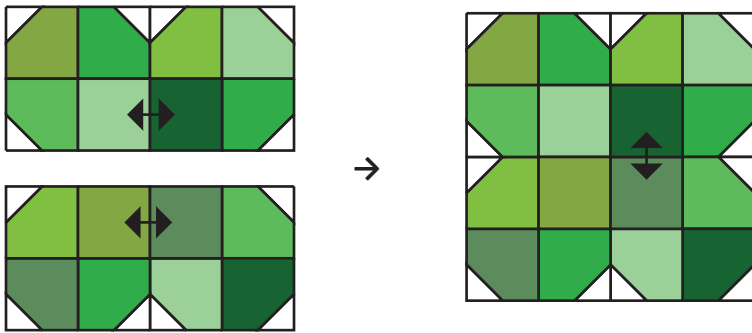
2. Sew together (4) 2 1/2" green squares to create a 4-patch. The 4-patch unit will measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" square. Make (4) 4-patch units.



3. Draw a diagonal line across the back of the 1 1/2" background squares. Place 3 background squares on three corners of each 4-patch unit as shown below. Orient the diagonals as illustrated. Sew on the marked lines. Press away from the center. Make sure all raw edges align. Trim out the bottom two layers leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. **Press seams open.** Repeat for all of the 4-patch units.



4. Sew the 4-patch units together. This unit will measure $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$ square.



5. Sew (4) HSTs together as illustrated. This unit will measure $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$ Make 2 sets.



6. Sew (6) HSTs together as illustrated. This unit will measure $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ Make 2 sets.



7. Sew together the $8\frac{1}{2}''$ center and the HST sets to complete the Scrappy Clover Block. It will measure $12\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$.
