HST Jelly Roll Block

Construct a total of 29 HST Jelly Roll Blocks

Cutting Instructions

29160JR	90 rectangles, 2 ½" x 13"	Α
29164-11	5 strips, 12 ½" x wof; subcut 15 squares, 12 ½" x 12 ½"	В

Tip

Cut the background fabric for the jelly roll blocks before cutting the monthly blocks.






block construction

RST=right sides together use a ¼" seam allowance read through all instructions before beginning

1. Sew together 6 print (A) rectangles to create a strip unit. Press seams in one direction. Trim the strip unit to 12 ½" x 12 ½". Make a total of 15 strip units.




2. Mark a diagonal line across the back of a background (B) square. Place the (B) square RST with the strip unit.

Make sure the marked diagonal line is running from the top left to the bottom right.

Make sure that the seams on the strip unit are running horizontally.

Sew 1/4" away from each side of the marked line. Cut the unit apart on the drawn line. Press the seam toward (B). You will have two half square triangles. Repeat to make a total of (30) half square triangles. You will use 29 of them in the quilt.

3. Trim the (29) HST Jelly Roll blocks to $12" \times 12"$.

Note: This measurement is correct. It is not the standard 12 $\frac{12}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{12}{2}$ " measurement we often see.
