Block 1: Sunny Greek Square
This month, construct (1) Sunny Greek Square.

## Cutting Instructions

|  | 1 rectangle, $2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ <br> 2 rectangles, $1 \frac{1}{4}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ | $\begin{aligned} & \text { A } \\ & \text { B } \end{aligned}$ |

* In each of the monthly patterns, you will have the option to simplify the block.

For this month, if you wish to eliminate the pieced center, do not cut pieces $A, B$, or $D$. Replace these pieces with (1) square of the background fabric cut at $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

Your completed block would look like this:


Look for the throughout the pattern for instructions to make the simplified version.

## block construction

RST=right sides together
use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance
read through all instructions before beginning
If you are opting to make the simplified block, skip to step 3.

1. Sew a (D) background square to each end of an $x$-print (B) rectangle. Press seams toward (B). Make 2. These units will each measure $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $31 / 2$ "

2. Sew the two units made in step 1 to the top and bottom of an $x$-print (A) rectangle. Press seams toward (A). The center unit will measure $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

3. Sew together the red print (C) strip and the background (E) strip. Press toward (C). The strip unit will measure $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 15^{\prime \prime}$.

4. Cut the strip unit into 4 segments; each measuring $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


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5. Lay out the block pieces as shown below. Sew together and press as illustrated. The block now measures $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
, If you are making the simplified block, substitute the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background square in place of the center unit made in step 2 .

6. Sew (G) borders to the sides of the block and (H) borders to the top/bottom. Press all seams away from the center. The completed block measures $12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$.

Note: This measurement is correct. It is not the standard $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ measurement we often see.
