

## Scrappy Heart Quilt Block

 12" Finished BlockFabrics needed to complete 1 block
(9) $3^{\prime \prime}$ pink squares
(5) $3^{\prime \prime}$ red squares
(6) $21 / 2 \prime$ red squares
(14) $3^{\prime \prime}$ background squares
(2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background squares

## Piecing Instructions

Press all seams open
RST = Right Sides Together
Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance throughout

1. Mark a diagonal line across the back of a $3^{\prime \prime}$ background square. Place the background square RST with a $3^{\prime \prime}$ pink square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the marked line. Cut the unit apart on the drawn line. Press the seams open.

You will have two half square triangles.
Trim each half square triangle to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat to make 18 pink/background half square triangles (HSTs).

2. Repeat step 1 using $3^{\prime \prime}$ background squares and $3^{\prime \prime}$ red squares to make a total of 10 red/background HSTs.

3. Lay out all of the HSTs along with all of the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares as shown. Sew the pieces together in horizontal rows, pressing seams open. Sew the rows together pressing the seams open to complete the Scrappy Tulip Block. It will measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
