Block 4: Sunny Square in a Square

This month, construct (1) Sunny Square in a Square.

## Cutting Instructions


Cutting instructions		
29167-41	1 square, 3 ½" x 3 ½" ★ 8 squares, 2" x 2"	A B
29162-19	4 squares, 3 ½" x 3 ½" 4 squares, 2" x 2"	C D
29164-11	16 squares, 2" X 2" ★ 4 rectangles, 2" x 3 ½"	E F
29164-21	2 borders, 1 ¾" x 9 ½" 2 borders, 1 ¾" x 12"	G H

In each of the monthly patterns, you will have the option to simplify the block.

For this month, if you wish to eliminate the pieced center, do not cut piece A. Additionally, you will only need 12 (E),

Replace these pieces with (1) square of the background fabric cut at 3 ½" x 3 ½".

Your completed block would look like this:



Look for the \* throughout the pattern for instructions to make the simplified version.


## block construction

RST=right sides together use a ¼" seam allowance read through all instructions before beginning


- rilyou are opting to make the simplified block, skip to step 3.
- 1. Draw a diagonal line across the back of 4 background (E) squares. Place one (E) square RST on the corner of an x-print (A) square.

Orient the diagonal as illustrated. Sew on the marked line. Press away from the center.

Make sure all raw edges align. Trim out the bottom two layers leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.




2. Repeat step 1 on the remaining corners as illustrated to create the center unit. The center unit will measure 3 ½" x 3 ½".



3. Draw a diagonal line across the back of 8 x-print (B) squares. Place one (B) square RST on the corner of a red print (C) square.

Orient the diagonal as illustrated. Sew on the marked line. Press away from the center.

Make sure all raw edges align. Trim out the bottom two layers leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.



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


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




4. Repeat step 3 on the adjacent corner.



5. Repeat steps 3 & 4 on the remaining corners using background (E) squares in place of the x-print (B) squares. The completed square in a square units will measure 3 ½" x 3 ½".




square in a square unit

Make a total of 4 square in a square units.

6. Sew together a background (E) square and a red print (D) square to make a 2-patch. Press toward **(D)**. The 2-patch will measure 2" x 3 ½". Make a total of (4) 2-Patch units.



7. Sew a background **(F)** rectangle to the bottom of each 2-patch to make a corner unit. Press toward (F). The corner unit will measure 3 ½" x 3 ½". Make 4.



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


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



- 8. Lay out the block pieces as shown below. Sew together and press as illustrated. The block now measures 9 ½" x 9 ½".
- ★ If you are making the simplified block, substitute the 3 ½" x 3 ½" background square in place of the center unit made in step 2.



9. Sew (G) borders to the sides of the block and (H) borders to the top/bottom. Press all seams away from the center. The completed block measures 12" x 12".

Note: This measurement is correct. It is not the standard 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" measurement we often see.
