

Piecing Instructions
Press as illustrated
RST = Right Sides Together
Use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout

## Scrappy Bunny Quilt Block <br> 12" Finished Block

Fabrics needed to complete 1 block
(2) $3^{\prime \prime}$ pink squares (block corners)
(2) $1^{\prime \prime}$ pink squares (bunny nose)
(2) $3^{\prime \prime}$ white squares
(14) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white squares
(4) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white squares
(4) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ white rectangles
(4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ " light gray squares
(16) $21 / 2 \prime$ " light gray squares
(4) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ dark gray squares (bunny eyes)

1. Mark a diagonal line across the back of a 3 " white square. Place the white square RST with a 3 " pink square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from each side of the marked line. Cut the unit apart on the drawn line.

You will have two half square triangles.
Trim each half square triangle to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21_{2}^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat to make 4 pink/white half square triangles (HSTs).

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2. Draw a diagonal line across the back of the (4) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ light gray squares. Place a light gray square on one corner of a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " white square as shown below. Orient the diagonal as illustrated. Sew on the marked lines. Press away from the center. Make sure all raw edges align. Trim out the bottom two layers leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press seams open. Repeat to make 4 units.

3. Draw a diagonal line across the back of the (4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ white squares. Place a white square on one corner of a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ light gray square as shown below. Orient the diagonal as illustrated. Sew on the marked lines. Press away from the center. Make sure all raw edges align. Trim out the bottom two layers leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press seams open. Repeat to make 4 units.

4. Draw a diagonal line across the back of the (4) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ dark gray squares. Place a dark gray square on one corner of a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ light gray square as shown below. Orient the diagonal as illustrated. Sew on the marked lines. Press away from the center. Make sure all raw edges align. Trim out the bottom two layers leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press seams open. Repeat to make 2 units.

5. Sew the other two marked $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ dark gray squares onto two of the units made in step 3 as shown below.

6. Draw a diagonal line across the back of the (2) $1^{\prime \prime}$ pink squares. Place a pink square on one corner of a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ light gray square as shown below. Orient the diagonal as illustrated. Sew on the marked lines. Press away from the center. Make sure all raw edges align. Trim out the bottom two layers leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press seams open. Repeat to make 2 units.

7. Lay out all of the pieces made in steps 1-6 along with the remaining $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white squares, the remaining $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ light gray squares, and the (4) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white rectangles as illustrated below. Sew the pieces together into 6 rows. Press adjacent rows in opposite directions as shown.

8. Sew the rows together to complete the bunny block.

Press the seams in one direction.
The completed block will measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Tip: If you are making multiple blocks to use in one project, press all seams open.
