

## Piecing Instructions

Press as illustrated
RST = Right Sides Together
Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance throughout

## Scrappy Carrot Quilt Block <br> 12" Finished Block

Fabrics needed to complete 1 block
(3) $3^{\prime \prime}$ orange squares
(6) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ orange squares
(2) $21 / 2 \prime$ green squares
(3) $3^{\prime \prime}$ white squares
(6) $1 \frac{1 / 2 \prime \prime}{}$ white squares
(22) $2 \frac{112}{2}$ " white square

1. Mark a diagonal line across the back of a 3 " white square. Place the white square RST with a $3^{\prime \prime}$ orange square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from each side of the marked line. Cut the unit apart on the drawn line.

You will have two half square triangles. Press toward the orange fabric.
Trim each half square triangle to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$. Repeat to make 6 orange/white half square triangles (HSTs).

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Press 2 of the HSTs open. They will be used for the tip of the carrot.

2. Draw a diagonal line across the back of the (6) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ white squares. Place a white square on one corner of a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ orange square as shown below. Orient the diagonal as illustrated. Sew on the marked line. Press away from the center. Make sure all raw edges align. Trim out the bottom two layers leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press seams open. Repeat to make 2 units.

3. Place marked $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white squares on opposite corners of a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ green square as shown below. Orient the diagonals as illustrated. Sew on the marked lines. Press away from the center. Make sure all raw edges align. Trim out the bottom two layers on each corner leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press seams open. Repeat to make 2 units.

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7. Lay out all of the pieces made in steps 1-3 along with the remaining $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white squares as illustrated below. Sew the pieces together into 6 rows. Press adjacent rows in opposite directions as shown.

8. Sew the rows together to complete the bunny block. Press the seams in one direction. The completed block will measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Tip: If you are making multiple blocks to use in one project, press all seams open.
