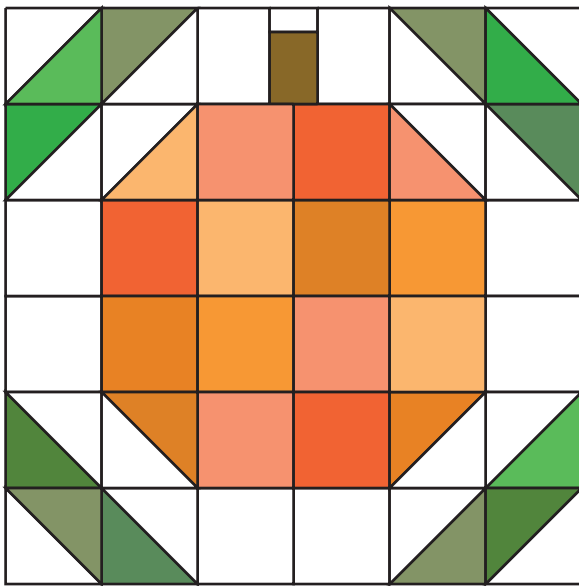




Scrapy Pumpkin Quilt Block 12" Finished Block

Fabrics needed to complete 1 block

- (2) 3" orange squares
- (12) 2 ½" orange squares
- (1) 1 ½" x 2" brown rectangle
- (6) 3" green squares
- (8) 3" white squares
- (6) 2 ½" white squares
- (1) 1" x 1 ½" white rectangle
- (2) 2" x 2 ½" white rectangles

Piecing Instructions

Press as illustrated

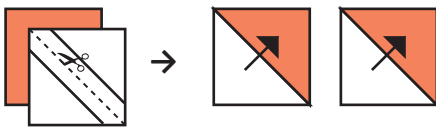
RST = Right Sides Together

Use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout

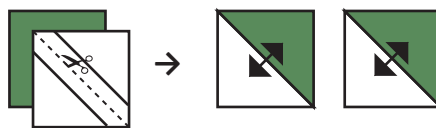
1. Mark a diagonal line across the back of a 3" white square. Place the white square RST with a 3" orange square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the marked line. Cut the unit apart on the drawn line.

You will have two half square triangles. Press toward the orange fabric.

Trim each half square triangle to 2 ½" x 2 ½". Repeat to make 4 orange/white half square triangles (HSTs).



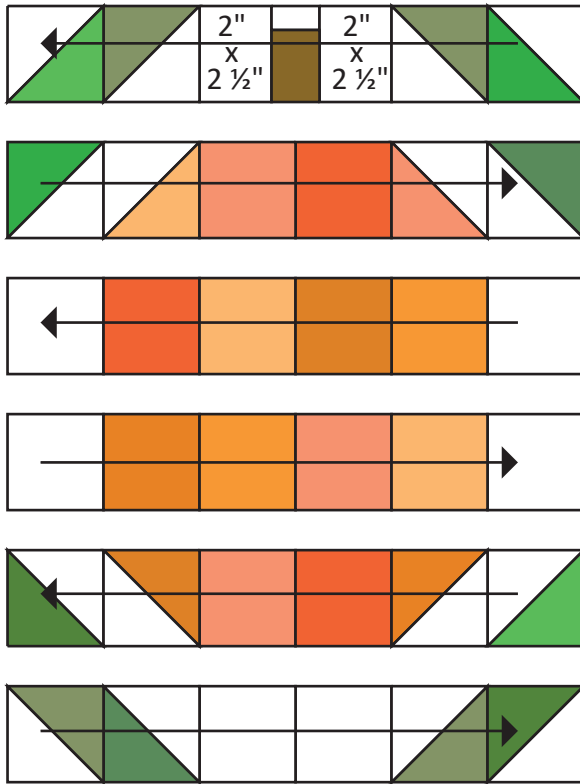
2. Repeat step 1 using 3" white squares and 3" green squares to make a total of 12 green/white HSTs. Press these seams open.



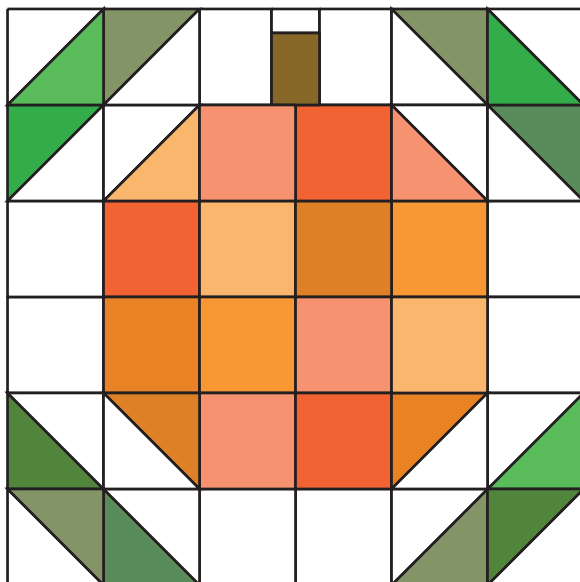
3. Sew the 1" x 1 ½" white rectangle to the top of the 1 ½" x 2" brown rectangle. Press toward the brown fabric.



4. Lay out all of the pieces made in steps 1-3 along with the remaining $2\frac{1}{2}$ " white squares and the (2) $2" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$ white rectangles as illustrated below. Sew the pieces together into 6 rows. Press adjacent rows in opposite directions as shown.



5. Sew the rows together to complete the pumpkin block. Press the seams in one direction. The completed block will measure $12\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$.



Tip: If you are making multiple blocks to use in one project, press all seams open.
