



In the Garden Mystery BOM Border 4

Cutting Instructions:

From the dark gray fabric (9900-170) cut:

(6) strips 2" x WOF **(A)**

From the white fabric (29231-31) cut:

(6) strips 2" x WOF **(B)**

(4) strips 4" x wof; subcut (40) squares, 4" x 4" **(C)**

Additional Fabrics Needed:

(40) print squares, 4" x 4" **(D)**

(40) print squares, 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" **(E)**

Piecing Instructions

RST = right sides together

use a 1/4" seam allowance

press all seams open

1. Sew a gray **(A)** strip and white **(B)** strip together. Press seam open. Repeat to make 6 sets.



2. Subcut each set into (20) 2-patch units measuring 2" x 3 1/2". [120 units total]



3. Sew (2) 2-patch units together to create a 4-patch unit measuring 3 1/2" x 3 1/2". Repeat to make (60) 4-patch units.

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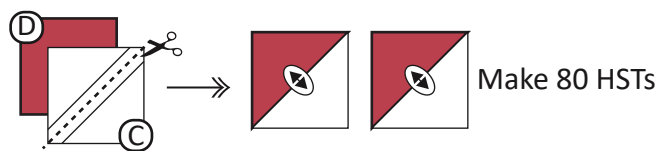


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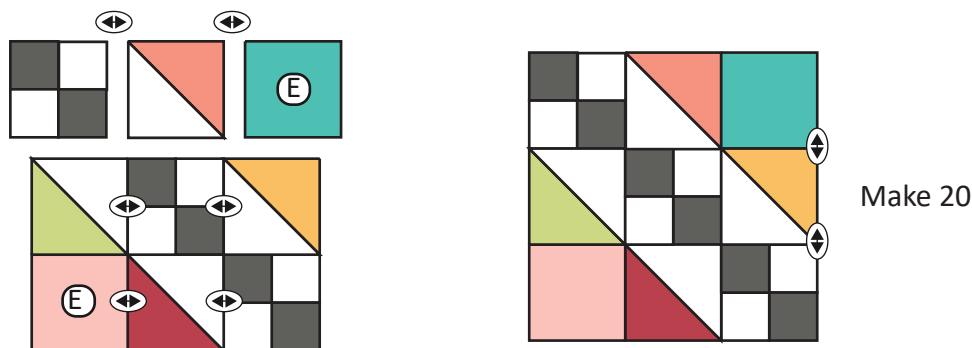


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4. Mark a diagonal line across the back of a **(C)** square. Layer the **(C)** square RST with a **(D)** square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut the unit apart on the marked line. Press seams open. You will have two half square triangles (HSTs). Trim each HST to 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" square. Repeat to make a total of 80 HSTs.



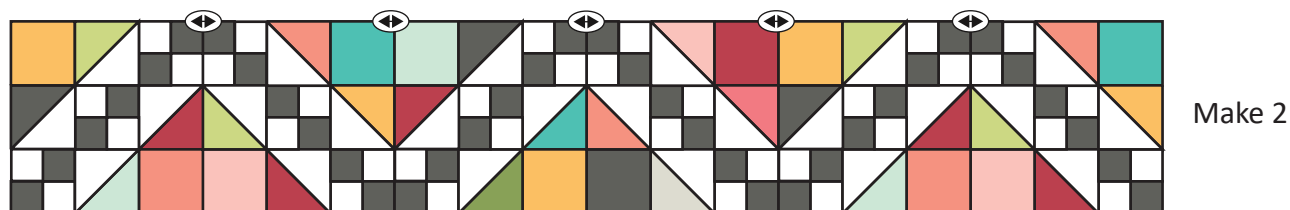
5. Sew 3 2-patch units, 4 HSTs, and 2 print **(E)** squares as shown to complete a block. Press all seams open. The completed block will measure 9 1/2" x 9 1/2". Make a total of 20 blocks.



6. Sew 4 blocks together as shown to create a side border. Note orientation of blocks. Press seams open. The side border will measure 9 1/2" x 36 1/2". Make two side borders.



7. Sew 6 blocks together as shown to create a top border. Note orientation of blocks. Press seams open. The top border will measure 9 1/2" x 54 1/2". Repeat to make a bottom border.



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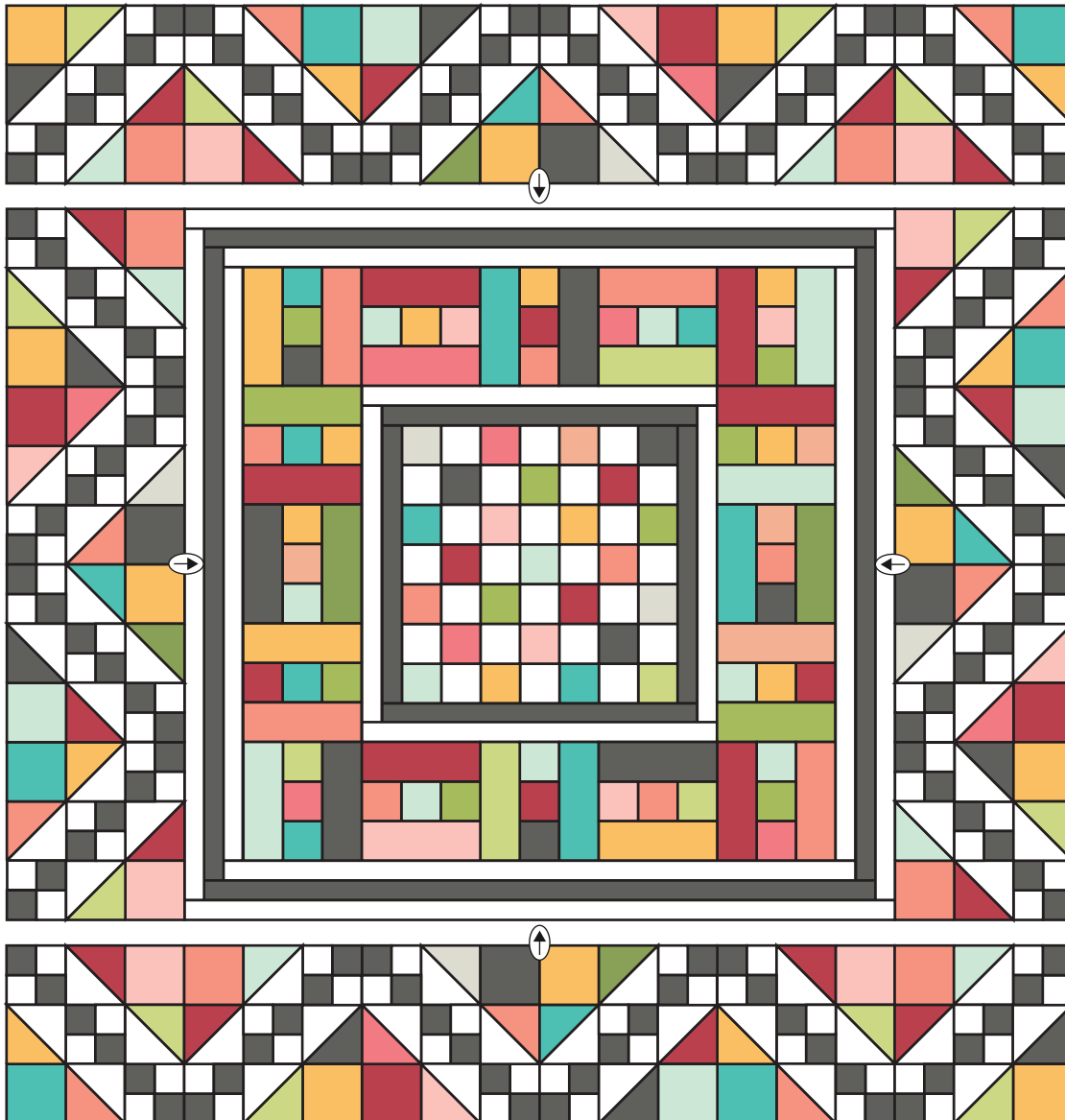


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8. Sew the side borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the center. Sew the top/bottom borders to the top/bottom of the quilt. Press toward the center. The quilt center will now measure 54 1/2" x 54 1/2".



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
